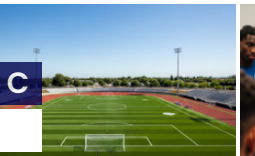
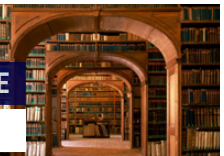

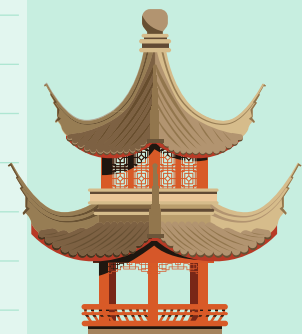
Hello! My name is Emma. I am from Canada so I am Canadian. I speak English and a little French. My favorite school club is science club because I love doing experiments.

School Rules and School Clubs

Interesting School Clubs Around the World



All around the world schools have fun and interesting clubs. These clubs help students learn new things, make friends and enjoy their time at school. Some clubs are very common like music clubs or science clubs. But some schools have very unique and exciting clubs too.

In **Japan**, there is a **robotics club**. Students build small robots and make them move or do tasks. They sometimes join robot competitions. It is a great way to learn about technology and teamwork.

In **South Korea**, some schools have a **calligraphy club**. Students learn how to write in a beautiful way using brushes and ink. It helps them focus and relax.

In the **United States**, there are **film clubs** in many schools. Students watch movies and talk about the story, characters and music. Some students also make their own short films using cameras and computers.

In **Türkiye**, some schools have a **folk-dance club**. Students wear traditional clothes and learn old dances from different parts of the country. They sometimes perform at school shows or festivals.

In **France**, there are **chess clubs** where students play and learn new strategies. It helps them improve their memory and thinking skills.

In **India**, some schools have an **environment club**. Students plant trees, clean up school gardens and learn about nature. They work together to protect our planet.

In **Brazil**, some schools have a **capoeira club**. Capoeira is a mix of dance and martial arts. Students move with music and learn balance, rhythm and strength.

In many countries there are also **art clubs**, **sports clubs**, **drama clubs** and **science clubs**. School clubs are a great way for students to explore their hobbies and grow as a person.

Every school is different but clubs make school more fun and interesting for everyone.

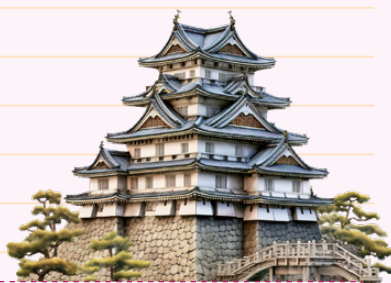

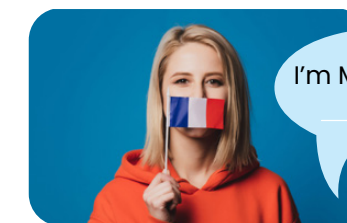
