





## **Interesting School Clubs Around the World**

All around the world schools have fun and interesting clubs. These clubs help students learn new things, make friends and enjoy their time at school. Some clubs are very common like music clubs or science clubs. But some schools have very unique and exciting

In Japan, there is a robotics club. Students build small robots and make them move or do tasks. They sometimes join robot competitions. It is a great way to learn about technology and

In South Korea, some schools have a calligraphy club. Students learn how to write in a beautiful way using brushes and ink. It helps them focus and relax.

In the United States, there are film clubs in many schools. Students watch movies and talk about the story, characters and music. Some students also make their own short films using cameras

In India, some schools have an environment club. Students plant trees, clean up school gardens and learn about nature. They work together to protect our planet.


In Brazil, some schools have a capoeira club. Capoeira is a mix of dance and martial arts. Students move with music and learn balance, rhythm and strength.
